## EXPLORATION IN CANADA

**Atocha Resources Inc. (TSX.V:ATT)** is a junior mining exploration and development company based in Canada. The Company has SIX GOLD PROJECTS in Canada, ONE located in BC, one in the Yukon, THREE in Quebec, and ONE in Ontario. Atocha's Atkinson (Detour Lake) Gold Project is located approximately 150 kilometres northeast of Cochrane, Ontario near the border between Ontario and Quebec, and is approximately 15 kilometres south of the past producing Detour Lake Mine. Last drilled in 2006, high-grade drill results including: 13m of 7.5 g/t Au and 7.7m of 14.2 g/t Au were encountered. (source: Paul R.J. Nichols (P.Eng) 43-101 February 2008).

### EXPLORING QUEBEC ABITIBI

Atocha Resources Inc. is a growth junior exploration mining company which continues to develop deeper ties to the Abitibi Greenstone Belt through the acquisition and development of gold properties. The company has acquired three Quebec properties which have been strategically chosen due to the following:

- Quebec is known for its gold and copper production and for hosting excellent infrastructure for exploration and mining

### BIJOU (Jewel) - 100% Owned

The 1,017 hectare property borders to the east and south of Bonterra's (TSX.V - BTR) Lavoie gold property which was drilled in the past with interceptions of gold bearing veins. The Bijou property consists of 18 claims and is located approximately 170km northeast of Val D'or and 125km southwest of Chibougamau, Quebec.

### TROVE - 100% Owned

The 1,500 hectare Trove property is located approximately 15km southwest of Eagle Hills (TSX.V - EAG) Windfall Lake gold property who has completed over 330 diamond drill holes with results as high as 52.3 oz/t over 4.8 metres.

### DESCOUCVERTE (Discovery) 100% Owned

Atocha completed a phase I exploration program in the fall of 2011 which included detailed geological mapping and sampling magnetometer and VLF-EM surveys and detailed humus grid sampling.

## ATOCHA RESOURCES GOLD PROJECTS

### TROVE

Forty nine (49) outcrops were mapped and identified with 19 rock samples sent for 59 element ultra-trace ICP analysis. Anomalous values included two gold values of 9 and 24 ppb Au and one zinc value of 1290 ppm (0.13%). The anomalous values, although low, are located along the contact between a biotite wacke and paragneiss coincident with a major fault (Barry fault) the contact between a volcano-sedimentary belt and plutonic complexes. This area is particularly interesting to the Company since it has a high potential for fault-controlled gold-bearing deformation zones.

A 26 line kilometre grid with 200 metre line spacing was established for the detailed humus sampling and magnetic and VLF-EM survey. A total of 1046 humus samples were taken at 25 meter stations using a soil auger, which were sent to Actlabs of Ste-Germaine-Boulé for 59 element ultra-trace ICP analysis. One sample, at L2+00/S7+75S, gave a highly anomalous gold value of 171 ppb Au. The VLF-EM survey identified four distinctive conductors all trending southwest to northeast.

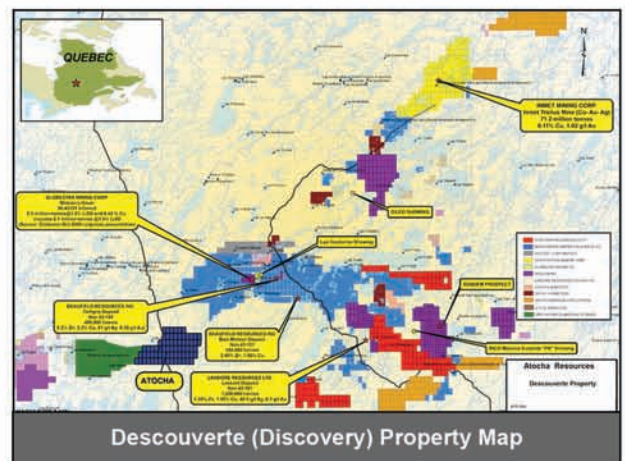
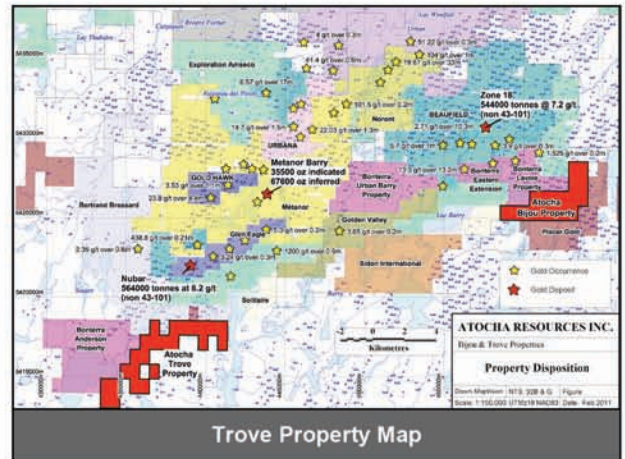
The conductor trends appear coincident with the two main regional structures in the area: the Rouleau and the Barry faults. Both trend SW-NE and dip toward the SE. The Rouleau fault lies along the contact between the Macho Formation to the north and the Chanceux Formation to the south while the Barry fault defines the contact between the Chanceux Formation to the north and the paragneiss unit to the south.

With the development of the Barry gold project and the re-opening of the Bachelor Lake mine, Atocha believes the Trove Property shows good potential for gold and base metals. Mineral showings in the vicinity are principally Au mineralization associated with quartz/carbonate veins related to deformation corridors in mafic volcanic and/or intrusive rocks.

### DESCOUCVERTE

The Descouverte (Discovery) Property consists of 3,877 hectares in 71 claims and is located approximately 10km southeast of Beaufield's Tortigny deposit (TSX.V – BFD). A helicopter-borne, DIGHEM EM/magnetic airborne geophysical survey was completed on the Descouverte property located in the Chibougamau area of the Abitibi of Quebec in 2011. The survey encompassed 439 line kilometres, with flight lines flown east - west at 100m intervals.

The Company hired a professional geophysicist to undertake a detailed interpretation of the survey data with seven areas of interest identified. The geology as mapped indicated a southwest to northeast trend while the airborne survey showed a strong geophysical magnetic anomaly over a 500 x 1000 meter area perpendicular to the regional geology.
